#### Registration Fees

# Objective

Our objective at Helen King Reynolds is to provide a pleasant and safe environment for the social, physical, emotional, and intellectual development of the child. In order to accomplish this, the school program will include many opportunities for social development, large and small muscle coordination, aesthetic appreciation, creative expression, and musical expression. Reading readiness, number concepts, and language development will also be integrated on an informal basis.





#### A. For the Child:
